DUMP : 18.04.2014, 14th DAY

MILDLY ECHOGENIC ?? MASS 4.8 x 3.8 mm (? SMALL POLYP)

SEEN IN THE ENDOMETRIAL CAVITY

ENDOMETRIAL THICKNESS 6.9 mm

OVARIES: B/L OVARIES APPEARS NORMAL IN SIZE & POSITION

8 - 10 FOLLICLES OF VARYING SIZES ARE SEEN ON BOTH SIDES.

LARGEST FOLLICLE ON THE RIGHT IS 11.2 mm & ON THE LEFT IS
15.4 mm IN SIZE

POUCH OF DOUGLAS: NO FREE FLUID SEEN.
NO ADNEXAL MASS SEEN

ULTRA SOUND - LOWER ABDOMEN

(SCAN DONE ON SIEMENS 4D USG MACHINE EQUIPPED WITH ELASTOGRAPHY)

Uterus is anteverted.

Myometrium shows normal echo-pattern. No focal space occupying lesion is seen.

A well marginated small anechoic ring seen in uterine cavity (appears to be a early gestational sac.)

GSD is 6.7 mm corresponding to 5 wks 3 days.

No evidence of any yolk sac or foetal node seen at the time of examination.

Adjacent endometrium appears thick (decidual reaction)

Both ovaries are visualized and are normal.

No adnexal mass is seen.

No free fluid is seen in pouch of douglas.

IMPRESSION :

*Early gestational sac.
